Opening Remarks

 - Getting up to speed systems, setup, finances, who does what
 - Court maintenance getting a multi year plan & supplier
 - Engage with stakeholder (Sport Club, Staff, Volunteers, Pavilion & Tennis)
 - Picking up in-flight and outstanding tasks


Health of Club

- 293 members in total
- 310 (I think was the peak in the 1970/88s)
- 40-50 junior members
- Excellent Ladies Squash sections




Sport activity by age

- Virtually no RacketBall under 30s
- Up to 50 predominantly Squash
- 50-70 more even, but Squash prevails



Sport activity by Sex

- Very even distribution of ladies squash by age
- 30-40 the most common age for of members
- 20-30 year old looking healthy numbers





EGM Split update

- Each section has a separate bank account,
- A lot of work has been put into understanding shared costs, governance and how to operate more independently
- March
 - Difference of opinion that lead to me becoming chair. Concern around:-
 - 5k per section VAT
 - Bar/Pavillion running costs risk
 - Clubhouse upkeep/maintenance no robust plan on how to fund
 - I needed to understand more and form and better opinion as only just chair
 - I had alternative priorities to focus on achieving some progress while I was Chair
- The position of all three sections currently is:-

"The desire for independence of financial decision making by each section is now being achieved, whilst at the same time operating and reporting as one club, Aylesbury Tennis and Squash Rackets Club. This offers continuity including the ability to share resources and common policies as appropriate, and benefits from the economies of scale. At the same time, we believe this offers a more agile, responsive and leaner organisation, with the operation and management of sections devolved to their respective committees."



Court Usage (& Scope for additional court)


- Court usage a challenge:-
- At certain times a year Sept-June
 - Not in holiday season, team squash, coaching, squash season)
- Certain times a month
 - end of month due to leagues

Bookings by time (court usage)

- Peak times 5-7.30pm Tuesday-Thursday
- Some activity Saturday/Sunday morning/evening





Scope for Additional Court

- Sports Club will work with squash around planning issues
- Court could be built next to Court 3 & 4
- Costs unknown, now have contacts to start pulling costs together
- Costings be brought back to members, there are other future investments that need to be considered
- It would be at least 3 years before Squash had enough capital
- Limited/no feedback from members, mixed opinions

Court Maintenance

- Booked for November
 - Aligned with just after half term (4th -13th)
 - Earlier in the month
 - Less dust issues e.g. Close off court 3 & 4 will buy a robot vac!
 - Court 4 Re-plastering of frontwall and floor sanding
 - Court 3 Re-plastering of court (currently painted) and floor sanding
 - Courtmasters England squash approved used by local clubs and local, maintained courts at Aylesbury historically
 - Courts 1&2 will be scheduled for early 2025





England Squash (& Membership Fees)

 England Squash is changing the way members are registered. Previously we registered you on your behalf, in the future you will need to purchase membership from England Squash directly.

A typical squash/rackeball player will typically opt for:-"JUST PLAY - £15 per year".

- Improved financial reporting by section, better control over spending
- Dedicated current bank account subs, court income, bills are paid + deposit account
- Agreement was reached on apportioning the shared costs e.g. utility costs, cleaning, and assessments
- Improved relations between the sections.
- Squash specific Profit and Loss Account
- 18k profit Squash income increased additional members
- Successful exhibition covered costs Thanks Tom and team
- England Squash changes members paying, subscription reduction
- Tax liability work nearing completion
- Risk around insurance, utility and wages increases absorbed
