

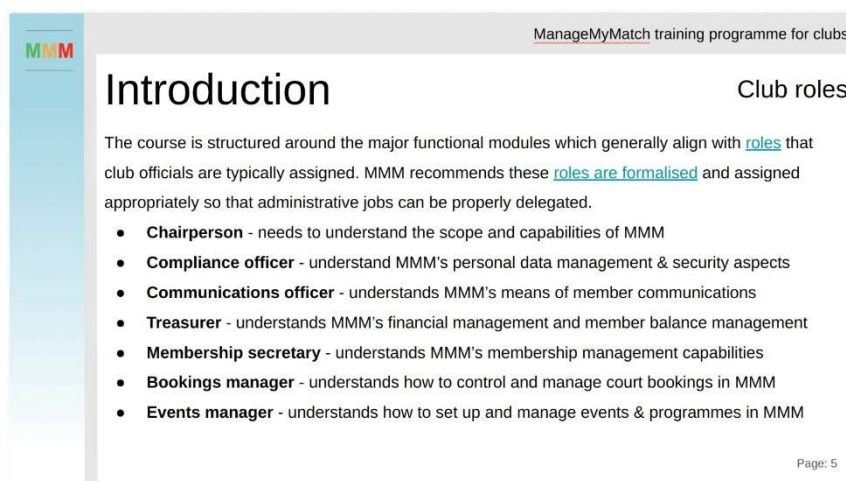
# Chairs Update

## IT and Technology

- **New website** - up and running [www.aylesburysquash.com](http://www.aylesburysquash.com), this is in WordPress and OF copied content from archive. This was due just before the AGM so we can share committee minutes, notes and papers.
- **Website Images** - Volunteer (Mike Cartright) has updated website with photos and came forward from request for a volunteer board (prototype).
- **Manage My Match** – Manual available, roles need to be allocated and committee members.



- **Electronic Training** - Squash, Tennis and the Bar now have an online panel for tracking and issuing out training to staff and volunteers. Courses include: Safeguarding, Data Protection, Fire training, First Aid. This is the preferred approach going forward and Admin/Chair can issue out accounts and training as required.
- **Office 365** - Now up and running with accounts for:-
  - Secretary
  - Finance
  - Oliver (Chair)
  - Admin
  - Data Protection Officer

All volunteers should store files within the office 365 tenant. Email access to committee folder will be granted.

- **Court Displays** – When network is lost, power failure, internet failure, these need resetting. This is fine for 2-4 as they can be accessed safely, however court 1 is too high and needs ladder to reset. Recommendation is for this to be moved to a lower more safe hight for accessing/resetting.

## Courts and Court Maintenance

- **Court 2 Water ingress and split board** - Court 2, out of action twice this month due to the water, 06/09 for 3 days and this Sunday 22/09 for 7 days. Drainage - surface drainage emergency work completed. Split floorboard repaired by Oliver and holding up fine.
- **Court 1 & 2 drainage** - Oliver/Builder have investigated the drains and it appears tree roots have damaged the pipes and caused blockage/limited water to pass all the way up. Court 1&2 drainage appears not to enter the main drainage or pipe is broken and water is not flowing at all into the drain. Perhaps a soakaway. Plan is to clean it out (need volunteer) and use camera for inspection.
- **Maintenance - Court 3/4** - This is still planned to commence on 4th November and the courts will be offline for just over a week. Court 3 - Maintenance 4th to 13th - Re-open 14th November. Court 4 - Maintenance 4th to 10th - Re-open 11th November.

## Squash Pavilion

- **Decorating Squash Corridors** – this is under way and should be completed in the next few weeks.
- **Showers** – Significant water damage is being cause by the showers, mixer taps do not work well, and ladies is under utilised due to configuration. Oliver is working with the other chairs (Bar & Tennis) to agree what percentage each section contributes, and this will be based on some structed data around usage.
- **Canvas Prints** – For changing rooms, corridors (a few), court 1 area & the bar. Oliver suggest the following, feedback from committee needed:-
