Opening Remarks

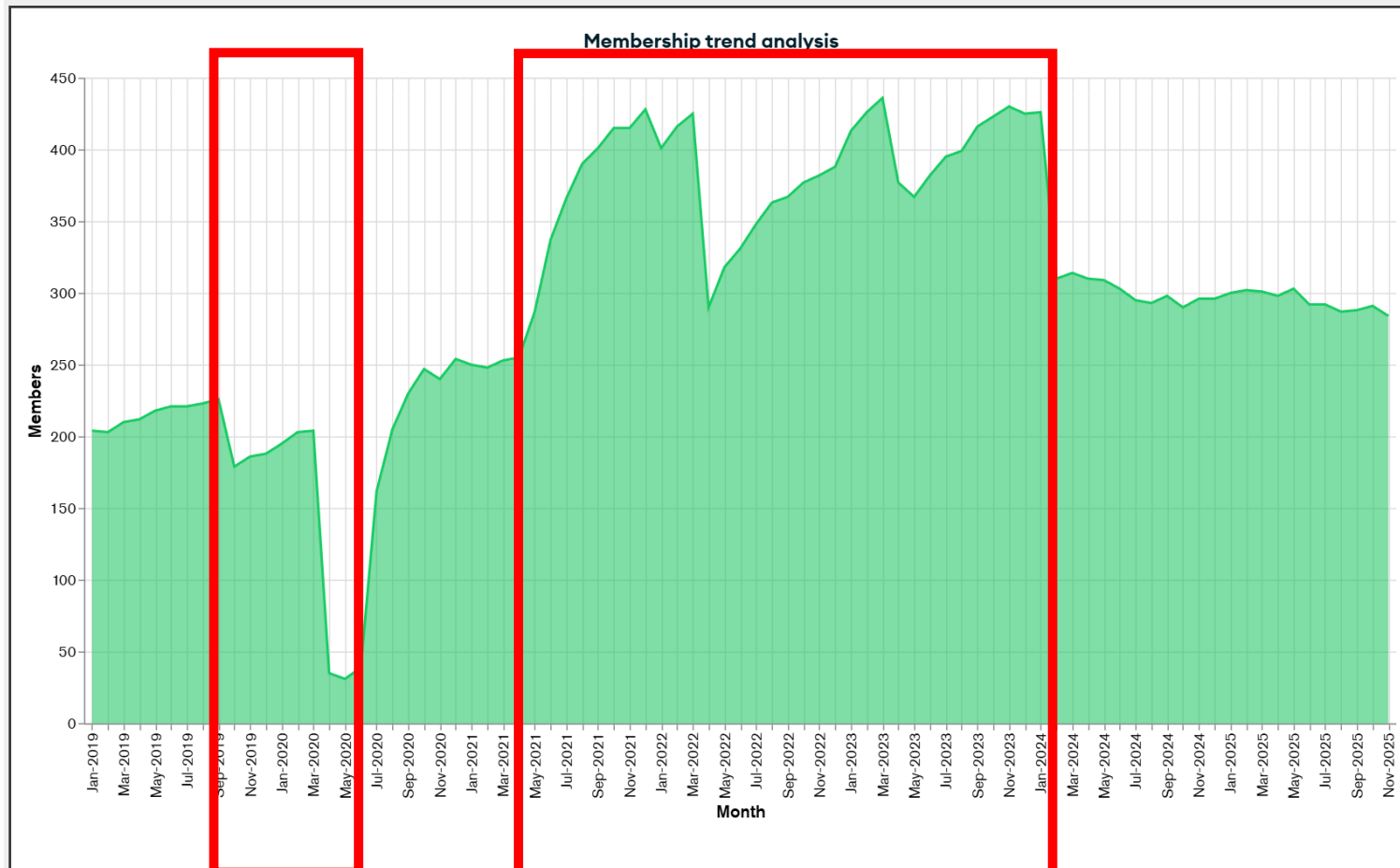
- Thanks for coming

Health of Club

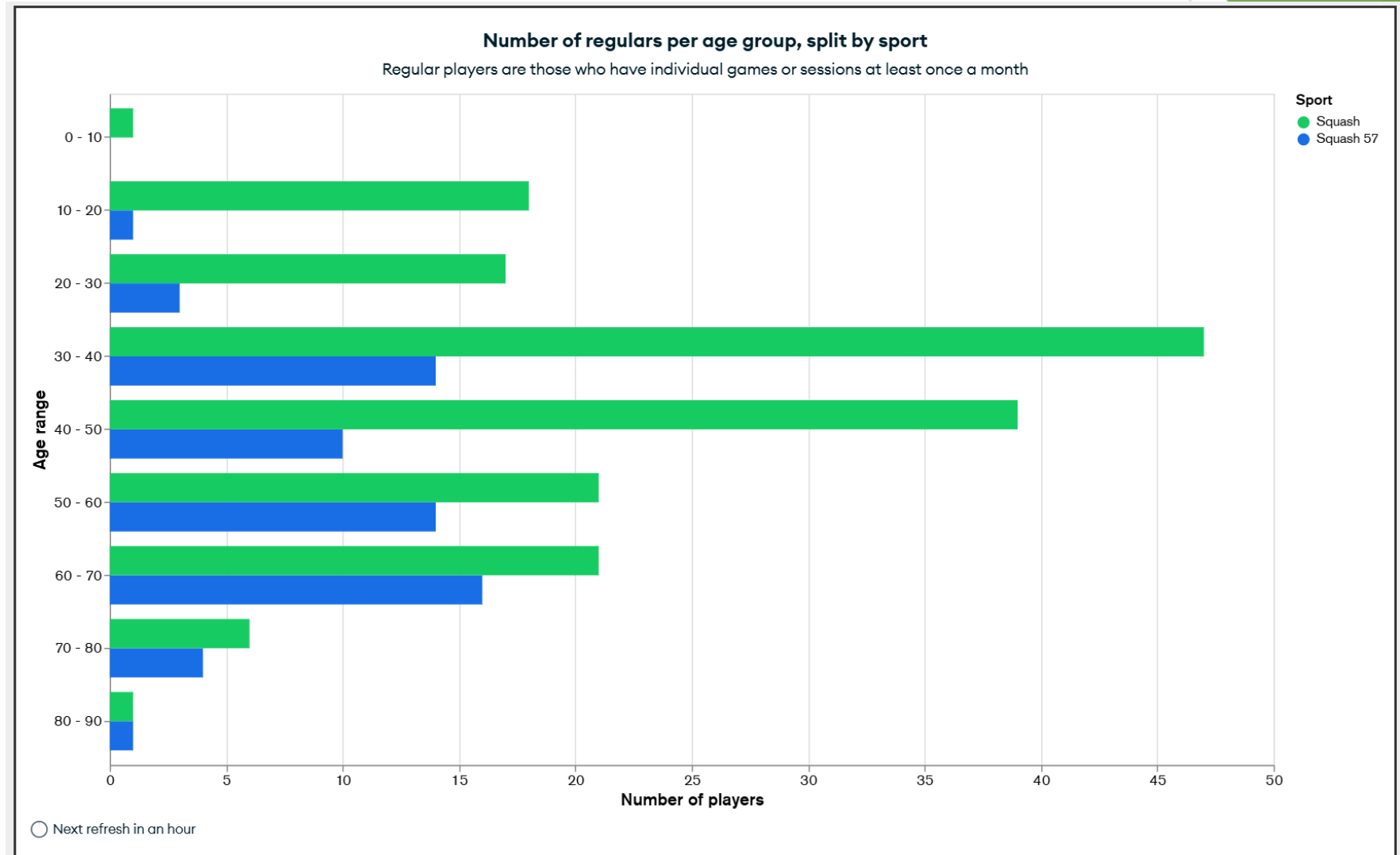

Tennis membership on MMM

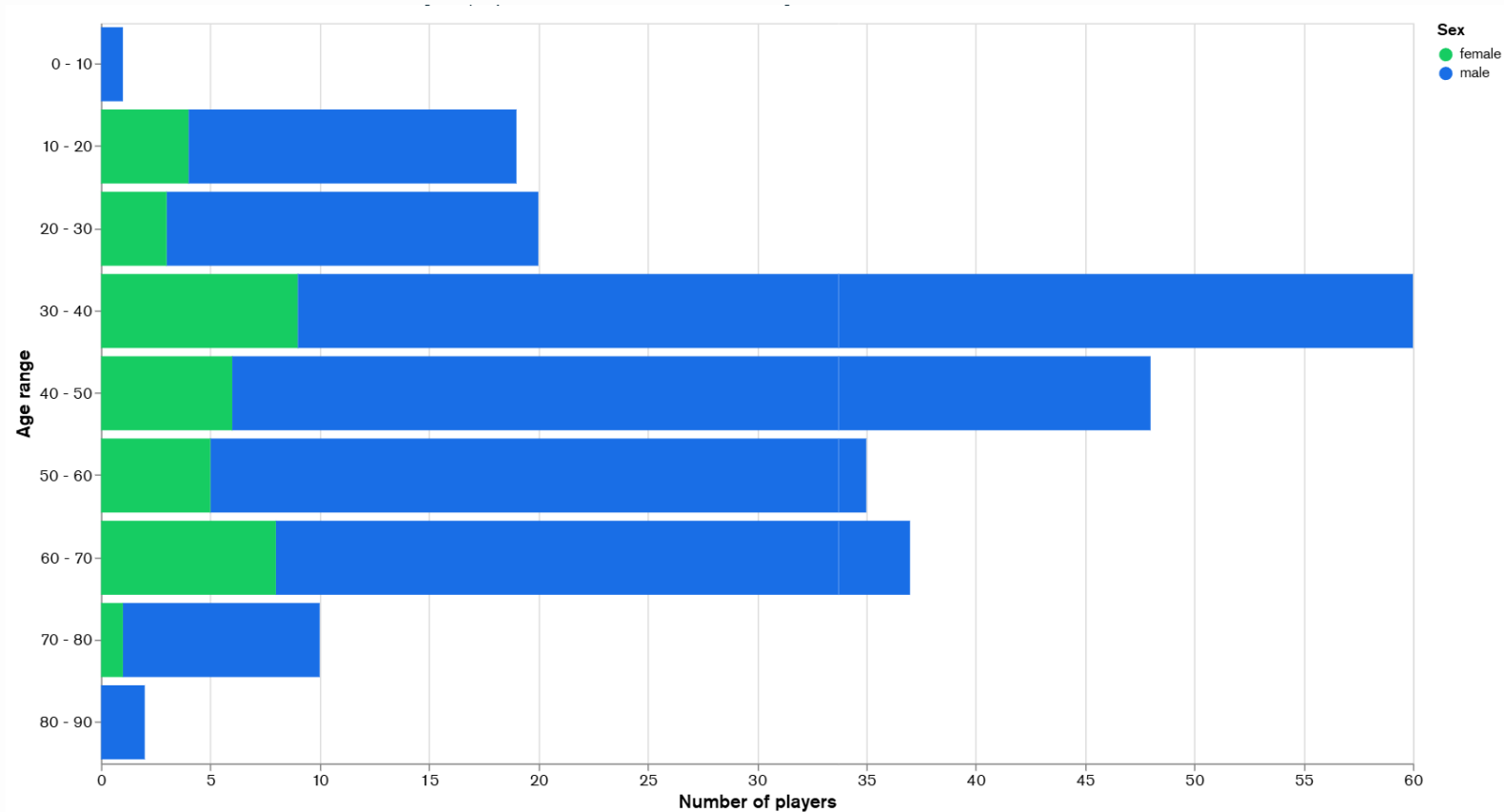
Sport activity by age

- Squash
 - 0-30, 70-80 small increase
 - 30-70 small decrease
- Racketball
 - 60-70 small increase
 - 70-80 small increase

Court Usage (& Scope for additional court)

- Court are busy over Sept-Feb,
- Fully booked 5-8pm - Mon-Thurs
 - Courts typically usually available 1 week in advance except certain days/times



Additional Court



- Court contention reduced slightly late 2024
- Paused while:-
 - We had all courts brought up to date (fully plastered)
 - Squash area was tidied up / decorated
 - Monitored Second year of bookings in peak season
- There is membership/court capacity currently – so will go on hold for another year

Court Maintenance

- All courts had full maintenance late 2024 and early 2025
- Court 2 Floor repaired early 2025
- Slight blown plaster on one of 3&4 – monitoring
- Drainage next to court 2 – temporary workaround - needs longer term drainage review – volunteers welcome
- Roof inspected late 2025 and in good condition
- Court 1 Gas Vent seal repaired late 2025

Treasurer Update – Bop Mistry

- Handover from previous Treasurer (Isabella Vasilescu) completed end Q2
- **Q3 highlights**
 - o Surplus Maintained : Squash still delivered a surplus in Q3, even with reduced income streams and no exhibition revenue.
 - o Cost Control : No exhibition costs and court maintenance, helping offset income decline.
 - o Stable Core Income : Membership subscriptions remain strong, only slightly down from Q2, showing continued member engagement.
 - o Year-to-Date Position : Despite Q3 softness, cumulative surplus for 2025 remains healthy compared to historical norms.
 - o Operational Efficiency : No unexpected cost spikes; establishment costs and coaching fees stayed consistent.

 AYLESBURY SQUASH CLUB CONSTITUTION DRAFT V1.1 (02/11/2025)	
NAME	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The club shall be called Aylesbury Squash Club (ASC) hereinafter referred to as 'The Club' and shall be affiliated to England Squash and Buckinghamshire Squash. This Constitution and Rules document shall be prominently displayed inside the Club's premises and on the Club's website.2. The name of the committee shall be Aylesbury Squash Club Committee, hereinafter referred to as 'The Committee'.3. The Aylesbury Squash Club operates as part of Aylesbury Tennis and Squash Club (ATSC) and is also subject to the Aylesbury Tennis and Squash Club Constitution and the overall Sports Club Constitution. The Committee shall report in accordance with these constitutions and ensure compliance with their governance requirements.4. To maintain coordination and representation between sections, there shall always be at least one <u>members</u> of the Aylesbury Squash Club Committee serving on both the ATSC Committee and the overall Sports Club Committee.	
GUIDANCE TO DEFINITION OF TERMS	
In this constitution, unless the context otherwise <u>requires</u> :	
The Club	means Aylesbury Squash Club
Member	means a member of the Club admitted from time to time to membership of the Club in accordance with this Constitution
AGM	means Annual General Meeting
ASDC	means Aylesbury Sports District Club
ATSC	means Aylesbury Tennis and Squash Club
The Clubhouse	means Aylesbury Tennis and Squash Clubhouse
Adult Member	means a member aged 18 and over
Conflict	means a situation in which a <u>Committee</u> member has or can <u>have</u> , a direct or indirect interest or loyalty that conflicts or possibly may <u>conflict</u> , with the interests of the Club
The Committee	means Aylesbury Squash Club Committee
